RLJ Lodging Trust

The real estate investment trust debuted as a public company in May. It later acquired the 176-room Courtyard by Marriott Charleston Historic District hotel for \$42 million, expanding its portfolio to 141 hotels in the United States. The company is an outgrowth of Black Entertainment Television founder Robert L. Johnson's wide-ranging investment company, RLJ Cos. Another unit, production studio Our Stories Films, released the feature film "Jumping the Broom" in May.
